4. DEANERY ACTIVITIES

- i. Each deanery should hold at least two (2) gatherings per year.

5. SUNDAY SCHOOL OUTREACH

- i. Each Sunday School should have at least one community project per year. Certificates to be given to all who participate.

6. TEACHER TRAINING

At least one training session should be held annually for all Sunday School Teachers

- 7. Each Deanery Should have a Sunday School Deanery Coordinator
- 8. Once a year there should be a Diocesan service for Sunday Schools coordinated by the Youth Department.
